**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:

Notice is hereby given that on 22 March 2018, Cagayan II Electric Cooperative, Inc. (CAGELCO II) filed an Application to seek the Commission's approval of its Emergency Capital Expenditure Project for the year 2018, consisting of uprating the mission Substation in Sta. Teresita, Cagayan from 5MVA to 15MVA.

In its Application, CAGELCO II alleged the following:

1. Applicant CAGELCO II is an electric cooperative duly organized and existing under Philippine law, with principal office address at Macanaya District, Aparri, Cagayan; franchised to distribute electricity in the municipalities of Abulug, Allacapan, Aparri, Ballesteros, Buguey, Calamaniugan, Claveria, Gattaran, Gonzaga, Lal-lo, Lasam, Pamplona, Sanchez Mira, Sta. Ana, Sta. Praxedes and Sta. Teresita, all in the Province of Cagayan; and the

municipalities of Flora, Luna, Sta. Marcela and Pudtol, all in the Province of Apayao. Its OIC-General Manager is Ms. Blandina Y. Madamba.

2. Due to the sudden unexpected entry of a large load, CAGELCO II's facilities will not be able to adequately serve the electricity requirements of all its customers. CAGELCO II is therefore proposing to undertake this emergency capital expenditure project to comply with its obligation to adequately serve the peak demand of its customers.
3. The proposed emergency capital expenditure project consists of the following:
  - a. Uprating of the existing substation at Mission, Sta. Teresita, Cagayan from 5MVA to 15 MVA;
  - b. Installation of corresponding 69kV protection and metering equipment, as well as a new Medium Voltage Switchgear with one (1) incoming main and three (3) outgoing feeders.
4. The replaced 5MVA power transformer will be refurbished and will serve as a buffer stock of CAGELCO II for future substation projects.
5. The project is estimated to cost P47,500,000.00.
6. CAGELCO II submits the following documents in support of the application:
  - a. Executive Summary;
  - b. Power Requirements of DataJ (Annex A);
  - c. 15 Year Demand Forecast (Annex B);
  - d. Substation Loading Analysis With and Without Project (Annex C) ;
  - e. Options/Alternatives Considered (Annex D);
  - f. Technical Analysis (Annex E); and
  - g. Bill of Materials (Annex F).

#### **PRAYER**

WHEREFORE, CAGELCO II respectfully prays for the approval of the proposed Emergency Capital Expenditure Project for 2018.

CAGELCO II also prays for such other relief or remedy as may just and equitable under the circumstances.

The Commission sets the Application for determination of compliance with the jurisdictional requirements, expository presentation, Pre-trial Conference, and presentation of evidence on

All persons who have an interest in the subject matter of the instant case may become a party by filing with the Commission a verified Petition to Intervene at least five (5) days prior to the initial hearing and subject to the requirements under Rule 9 of the 2006 Rules of Practice and Procedure, indicating therein the docket number and title of the case and stating the following:

1. The petitioner's name and address;
2. The nature of petitioner's interest in the subject matter of the proceeding and the way and manner in which such interest is affected by the issues involved in the proceeding; and
3. A statement of the relief desired.


All other persons who may want their views known to the Commission with respect to the subject matter of the case may file their Opposition or Comment thereon at any stage of the proceeding before Applicant rests its case, subject to the requirements under Rule 9 of the 2006 Rules of Practice and Procedure. No particular form of Opposition or Comment is required, but the document, letter, or writing should contain the following:

1. The name and address of such person;
2. A concise statement of the Opposition or Comment; and
3. The grounds relied upon.

All such persons who wish to have a copy of the Application may request from Applicant that they be furnished with the same, prior to the date of the initial hearing. Applicant is hereby directed to furnish all those making such request with copies of the Application and its attachments, subject to the reimbursement of reasonable photocopying costs. Any such person may likewise examine the Application and other pertinent records filed with the Commission during the standard office hours.
