ORDER

Before the Commission for resolution is the *Motion for Reconsideration (to the Order granting TransCo's Petition to Intervene)* filed by the National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) on 09 March 2020.

NGCP, in its *Motion for Reconsideration*, reiterated its position that pursuant to the Concession Agreement, TransCo has no personality before the Commission in all matters relating to the operation of the transmission assets. NGCP prayed that the Commission reconsider its 17 February 2020 *Order* granting the *Petition for Intervention* of TransCo and admitting it as an intervenor.

COMMISSION'S RULING

The Commission **DENIES** the *Motion for Reconsideration* filed by NGCP. Finding no new issues or positions raised; and that the grounds invoked by Movant are just mere rehash of its initial position in its *Comment to the Petition for Intervention* filed by TransCo, the

Commission does not find any cogent reason to disturb its 17 February 2020 *Order*.

WHEREFORE, the foregoing premises considered, the *Motion for Reconsideration* filed by the National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) on 09 March 2020 is hereby **DENIED**. **ACCORDINGLY**, the *Order* dated 17 February 2020 admitting TRANSCO as intervenor in the instant case is hereby **AFFIRMED**.
