ORDER

On December 15, 2014, the Cagayan I Electric Cooperative, Inc. (CAGELCO I) filed an application for approval of its force majeure capital expenditure project due to Typhoon Luis.

In the said application, CAGELCO I alleged, among others, that:

1. It is an electric cooperative duly organized and existing under Philippine law with principal office address at Maddarulug, Solana, Cagayan. It is authorized to construct, own operate, and maintain an electric distribution network in the City of Tuguegarao, and in the Municipalities of Alcala, Amulung, Baggao, Enrile, Iguig, Peñablanca, Piat, Rizal, Solana, Sto. Niño, and Tuao, all in the Province of Cagayan;
2. On September 14, 2014, Typhoon Luis unleashed its fury in Northern Luzon and inflicted heavy damage to the Province of Cagayan, more particularly to its electric distribution network;

3. It prepared a detailed assessment of the damage sustained by its electric distribution network as contained in its Final Count of Line Damages due to Typhoon Luis. As a consequences thereof, its member-consumers suffered outages resulting from the damaged facilities;
4. It was constrained to undertake immediate repair and restoration works of its damaged facilities to spare its member-consumers from the further prolonged power interruptions, thereby benefiting the member-consumers in terms of reducing the duration of power interruptions;
5. It submitted, in support of its application, the following documents:
 - a. Force majeure capital projects justifications due to Typhoon Luis as Annex "A";
 - b. Cost of line and equipment damaged due to Typhoon Luis as Annex "B"; and
 - c. Final count of line damaged due to Typhoon Luis as Annex "C"; and
6. It prays that after due notice and hearing, its application for force majeure capital project due to Typhoon Luis be approved by the Commission.

Finding the said application sufficient in form and in substance with the required fees having been paid, the same is hereby set for jurisdictional hearing, expository presentation, pre-trial conference and evidentiary hearing on **February 13, 2015 (Friday) at ten o'clock in the morning (10:00 A.M.), at the CAGELCO I's Main Office, Maddarulug, Solana, Cagayan.**

CAGELCO I is hereby directed to cause the publication of the attached Notice of Public Hearing, at its own expense, twice (2x) for two (2) successive weeks in two (2) newspapers of general circulation in the Philippines, with the date of the last publication to be made not later than ten (10) days before the date of the scheduled initial hearing. It is also directed to inform the consumers within its franchise area, by any other means available and appropriate, of the filing of the instant application, its reasons therefor and of the scheduled hearings thereon.

Let copies of the application, this Order, and the attached Notice of Public Hearing be furnished the Office of the Solicitor General (OSG), the Commission on Audit (COA) and the Committees on Energy of both Houses of Congress. They are hereby requested, if they so desire, to send their duly authorized representatives at the scheduled hearings.

Likewise, let copies of this Order and the attached Notice of Public Hearing be furnished the Offices of the Governor of Cagayan and the Mayors of the City/Municipalities within the franchise area of CAGELCO I for the appropriate posting thereof on their respective bulletin boards.

CAGELCO I is hereby directed to furnish all those making requests therefor with copies of the application and its attachments, subject to reimbursement of reasonable photocopying costs.

On the date of the initial hearing, CAGELCO I must submit to the Commission its written Compliance with the jurisdictional requirements attaching therewith, methodically arranged and duly marked, the evidences of the actual posting and publication of the Notice of Public Hearing consisting of certifications issued to that effect, signed by the afore-mentioned Governor and Mayors or their duly authorized representatives, bearing the seals of their offices, and the affidavits of the Editors or Business Managers of the newspapers where said Notice of Public Hearing were published together with the complete issues of the said newspapers, and such other proofs of compliance with the requirements of the Commission.

CAGELCO I and all interested parties are directed to submit, at least five (5) days before the date of initial hearing and pre-trial conference, their respective Pre-Trial Briefs containing, among others:

- (a) A summary of admitted facts and proposed stipulation of facts;
- (b) The issues to be tried or resolved;
- (c) The documents or exhibits to be presented, stating the purposes thereof and proposed markings therefore; and

- (d) The number and names of the witnesses, with their written testimonies in an individual affidavit form, to be attached to the Pre-Trial Brief.

Failure of CAGELCO I to submit the required Pre-Trial Brief and Judicial Affidavits of its witnesses within the prescribed period shall be a ground for cancellation of the scheduled hearing, and the resetting of which shall be six (6) months from said date of cancellation.

As part of the pre-trial conference, CAGELCO I must also be prepared to make an expository presentation of its application, aided by whatever communication medium that it may deem appropriate for the purpose, in order to put in plain words and explain, for the benefit of the consumers and other concerned parties, what the application is all about and the reasons and justifications being cited in support thereof.
