

## FAQ on Transmission Sector

**Question: HOW WILL YOU DESCRIBE THE TRANSMISSION SECTOR?**

**Answer:** Section 7 of the EPIRA categorically states that the transmission of electric power is a regulated common electricity carrier business subject to the ratemaking powers of the ERC. The National Transmission Company (TransCo), a Government-Owned or Controlled Corporation (GOCC) wholly owned by the Power Sector Assets and Liabilities Management Corporation (PSALM) was given the nationwide franchise to operate the transmission system and the grid. It is the only entity comprising the transmission sector.

The TransCo is responsible for the planning, construction, and centralized operation and maintenance of its high voltage transmission facilities, including grid interconnections and ancillary services.
